Sunday, April 14, 2019

- Breakfast** A buffet breakfast is included at the hotel.
- 8:30 am** Take a guided walking/driving tour of Boston, including parts of the Freedom Trail, the Old North Church, Old Ironside, and Bunker Hill. Other sights include Fenway Park, Boston Common, Copley Square, The Big Dig, and Newbury Street.

Faneuil Hall** Spend the rest of the afternoon at Quincy Market and Faneuil Hall, for shopping and exploring.
- 2:30 pm** Meet outside Faneuil Hall.

Monday, April 15, 2019

- Breakfast** A buffet breakfast is included at the hotel.
- 9:00 am** See the rock on the shore of Plymouth Harbor at the Plimoth Plantation that has become a world famous symbol of the courage and faith of the men and women who founded the first New England colony. Climb onboard the reproduction of the 17th-century merchant ship Mayflower that brought the Pilgrims to Plymouth in 1620 with interpreters and 17th-century role-playing re-enactors, exhibits relating to the story of the 1620 journey as well as information on the building and sailing of Mayflower II in 1957. (Hours: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm)
- Lunch** On your own in Plymouth
- 1:00 pm** Load coach and depart for Boston.
- 2:00 pm** Arrive at John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum. Step back into the recreated world of the early 1960's and the Kennedy presidency. The national memorial features three theaters, period settings and 20 dramatic exhibits. Research President Kennedy's life, career and the times in which he lived. (Hours: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm)
- ♪ 2:30 pm** Perform for the public at the John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum (30 minutes).
- 3:40 pm** Film time
- 5:15 pm** Depart for the Boston Harbor.
- 6:00 pm** Begin boarding for the Boston Harbor dinner cruise.
- 7:00 pm** Boston Harbor dinner cruise with DJ dance

Tuesday, April 16, 2019

- Breakfast** A buffet breakfast is included at the hotel.
- 9:00 am** A guide will take you to Lexington and Concord, where on April 19, 1775, British troops marching to Concord first encountered a band of Minutemen at Lexington Green, where the first shots were fired in the Revolutionary War. The Green today is pretty much as it was on that April morning. Other sites you will see are Munroe Tavern, Buckman Tavern, Hancock/Clarke House, Minute Man National Park, Battle Road and North Concord Bridge.
- Lunch** On your own in Cambridge.
- Cambridge** Explore Cambridge today, with time to stroll through the lively campus of Harvard University.
- Boston Common** Enjoy some free time walking around the beautiful Boston Common, the oldest park in the country. British troops prepared for the Revolution on these 50 acres, and left from here to face battle at Lexington and Concord in April, 1775. Take some time to enjoy a Swan Boat ride around the Lagoon (admission not included), or view the famous *Make Way for Ducklings* sculpture. Mrs. Mallord and her 8 ducklings were the subject of Robert McCloskey's famous 1941 book, which has sold over two million copies.
- 5:00 pm** Group dinner at the Hard Rock Cafe
- 7:30 pm** Enjoy a performance of the Blue Man Group. Critics describe them as "visually stunning" and "musically powerful." Blue Man Group is best known for its award-winning theatrical productions which showcase their unique style of music played on a variety of creative instruments.
